



CLUFF AND CORBETTI GEOTHERMAL PROJECTS: DIT SUPPLIER EVENT

Department for International Trade in partnership with Fieldfisher, invites UK companies interested in geothermal supply chain opportunities in Ethiopia to attend a supplier event on 26th October from 9:00 to 13:00 at Fieldfisher, Riverbank House, 2 Swan Lane EC4R 3TT, UK. Cluff Geothermal and Corbetti Geothermal are looking to meet UK suppliers to be partners to support the design, build and operation of their geothermal plants in Ethiopia as well as further worldwide projects going forward.

Cluff geothermal, a British power developer is planning to build a large-scale 400 MW geothermal power project in Ethiopia, with 2 billion dollars investment value. The project will be developed in 4 phases, the 1st phase will generate 50 MW (\$ 300Million), 2nd & 3rd phase 100 MW each and 4th phase 150 MW.

Corbetti Geothermal is Ethiopia's first Independent Power Project and will become Africa's largest geothermal energy project. The project is expected to generate 500 MW and will be developed in 5 phases. The 1st phase will be construction of 10 MW (\$60 million), 2nd & 3rd phase 50MW each (\$250 million each), 4th phase 150MW (600 million) and 5th Phase 260MW (£1 billion).
