
Who we work with...

Delivering change at market and supply chain scale requires strong and strategic external partnerships. To drive alignment, we actively engage with government departments, regulators and standards bodies, including DESNZ, DEFRA, DBT, Ofgem and BSI.

We contribute to key cross-sector groups such as the Joint Trade Association (JTA) and the REACH Cross-Sector Working Group, and are involved in a number of All Member Parliamentary Groups (APPGs). At a European level, we represent industry perspectives on decarbonisation and the circular economy through leading trade bodies including T&D Europe, CECAPI and Orgalim.

The BEAMA 2050 Connected workplan is shaped by the issues that matter most to industry, addressing the realities which supply chains face. It is also informed by emerging policy and regulatory developments, ensuring subscribers remain ahead of evolving compliance requirements and market expectations.


We draw directly from the priorities identified within our committees and associated working groups, where technical questions and practical challenges are regularly shared and actively addressed.


