Engagement with BEIS - Rules of Origin

Wider political and media engagement

- Following Boris Johnson's Great Brexit speech last week EURIS wrote to the Foreign Secretary to express concern about an answer he gave during the Q&A session after the speech. In an answer to a question on EU regulatory alignment, Johnson indicated that whilst he would be fine with the UK choosing to stay aligned with EU rules on items such as washing machines for the sake of supply chains, he objects to the idea of the UK making a treaty commitment to do that. EURIS used our letter to express concern about this and explain why.
